The LiveNet project seeks to establish a Europe-wide network of livestock advisors to enhance knowledge exchange and foster the adoption of innovative solutions for sustainable livestock production by farmers.


These solutions will be economically viable, environmentally sustainable, adaptable, and mindful of animal welfare.

The project is based on an EU-wide network of advisors specialised in livestock production, spanning:

- The 27 EU Member States, the United Kingdom, and Switzerland
- All European pedo-climatic zones
- Multiple livestock sectors: dairy and beef, sheep and goats, poultry and pigs



Objectives

-  To establish and sustain an EU-wide network of livestock advisors, enhancing skills, capacity, and long-term knowledge exchange on sustainable practices
-  To collect, select, evaluate, analyse, adapt, and translate 100 Innovative Advisory Practices for sustainable livestock production within a multi-actor framework across 29 European countries
-  To promote innovative advisory practices for sustainable livestock production through targeted knowledge exchange and scaling activities tailored to national contexts
